Overview

Appalachian State University ranks 8 out of 261 schools in the 2027 College Free Speech Rankings with a score of 76 and a C speech climate grade. The campus earns a “green light” Spotlight rating. Appalachian State is part of the University of North Carolina System, which has affirmed the pro-free speech Chicago Statement and adopted a commitment to institutional neutrality.

Appalachian State ranks in the top 25 for “Administrative Support,” suggesting students trust the administration to defend free speech.

Appalachian State should respond clearly and forcefully whenever censorship occurs or is demanded. Doing so will demonstrate the university’s commitment to free speech and maintain community trust that the administration will defend expressive rights.

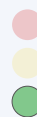

38% of students say they have self-censored on campus at least once or twice a month.



75% of students say shouting down a speaker to prevent them from speaking on campus is acceptable, at least in rare cases.



32% of students say using violence to stop someone from speaking on campus is acceptable, at least in rare cases.
